Tour of Iowa Capitol Complex Friday, October 28, 2016 3:00 p.m. - 5:00 p.m.

The Capitol building houses the executive offices of the Governor, Attorney General, Auditor, Secretary of State and State Treasurer on the first floor. A Supreme Court Chamber is also available but the court normally meets in its own facilities near the complex. In addition this floor also is home to a replica of the USS Iowa Battle Ship. There are also a military flag display from the Civil War and 1st World War.

It is the only five-domed state house in the nation. Its unique 23-carat gold coated dome was revitalized recently. A crane was used for the workman descended down to apply the gold coating.

Built in 1886 the second floor contains a Law Library on the west half which continues on the same side of the third level. The public spaces on the second floor are adorned with murals, which were painted in the early 1900s. The legislative chambers for the Senate and House of Representatives are also on these levels.

The Dome that is accessible provides a great view of the surrounding area including the downtown and adjacent government buildings.
